

WHY IS MY SCOOTER PARKED IN THIS PARKING SPACE?

Scooters and mopeds are no longer allowed to park at bike racks. Violators will be issued a \$50 ticket if they do not park in metered parking or designated parking areas which fill up quickly due to high demand. (A car parking violation is only a \$30 fine.)

Please contact the Rehoboth City Manager Mr. Gregory J. Ferrese if you are not happy with the outcome of 2 new ordinances just passed (see below) which are forcing scooter owners to park in metered parking spaces.

The commissioners of Rehoboth Beach have voted to adopt 2 new regulations: The \$40 Scooter Parking Fee and they have created a few scooter parking corals.

The imposed fine for parking a scooter in undesignated areas is \$50. Metered parking fines are only \$30.

This smacks as discrimination against anyone who owns a scooter and parks it in downtown Rehoboth Beach unless parked in a metered parking space or scooter coral.
