After receiving his MBA from Duke in 2001, Mike ascended to the Vice President level in Fannie Mae's Multifamily Division where he built several organizations from the ground up in disciplines such as marketing, strategy, operations, and financial engineering. He left Fannie Mae in 2009 to become the Executive Director for Ocean Champions, the country's only ocean-focused political organization.
