Dear Mr. Dusbiber:

The Solid Waste Management Branch has evaluated your request in reference to your daily beach/boardwalk cleanup and trash removal. The following information expresses our findings.

Your operation includes the utilization of vehicles and equipment specially designed to function in a sandy environment. The transport of wastes from the beach/boardwalk to a daily holding area is performed with the aforementioned equipment. The wastes are then removed from the holding area and transported each day, by trucks having both a DSWA license and a DNREC Transporter permit, to the appropriate DSWA landfill. No wastes are left unattended overnight or on weekends.

This operation does not exhibit the activities necessary to be considered a transfer station. You are required to provide continuous assurance that the site is well maintained, wastes removed daily, and does not cause a health hazard or become a nuisance.
